



License Plate Lookup Authority Still Dominates

However, the DMV will only release this information to two sets of people -- law enforcement officials and licensed private investigators.

Unfortunately, most people do not know this, which is why Docusearch has campaigned so hard to bring awareness. The company has published more than half a dozen articles on the intricacies of license plate lookups, covering everything from accessing DMV information, the problems associated with automated searches, and the costs associated with legitimate lookups. The most important thing consumers need to know?

If a website is not run by licensed private investigators, it cannot provide its customers with current information. Instead, those websites are forced to use historical databases, which are typically several years out of date.
